The children planted flower seeds to study the growth cycle of plants. It was exciting for them to watch their seeds sprout into saplings and begin to grow!



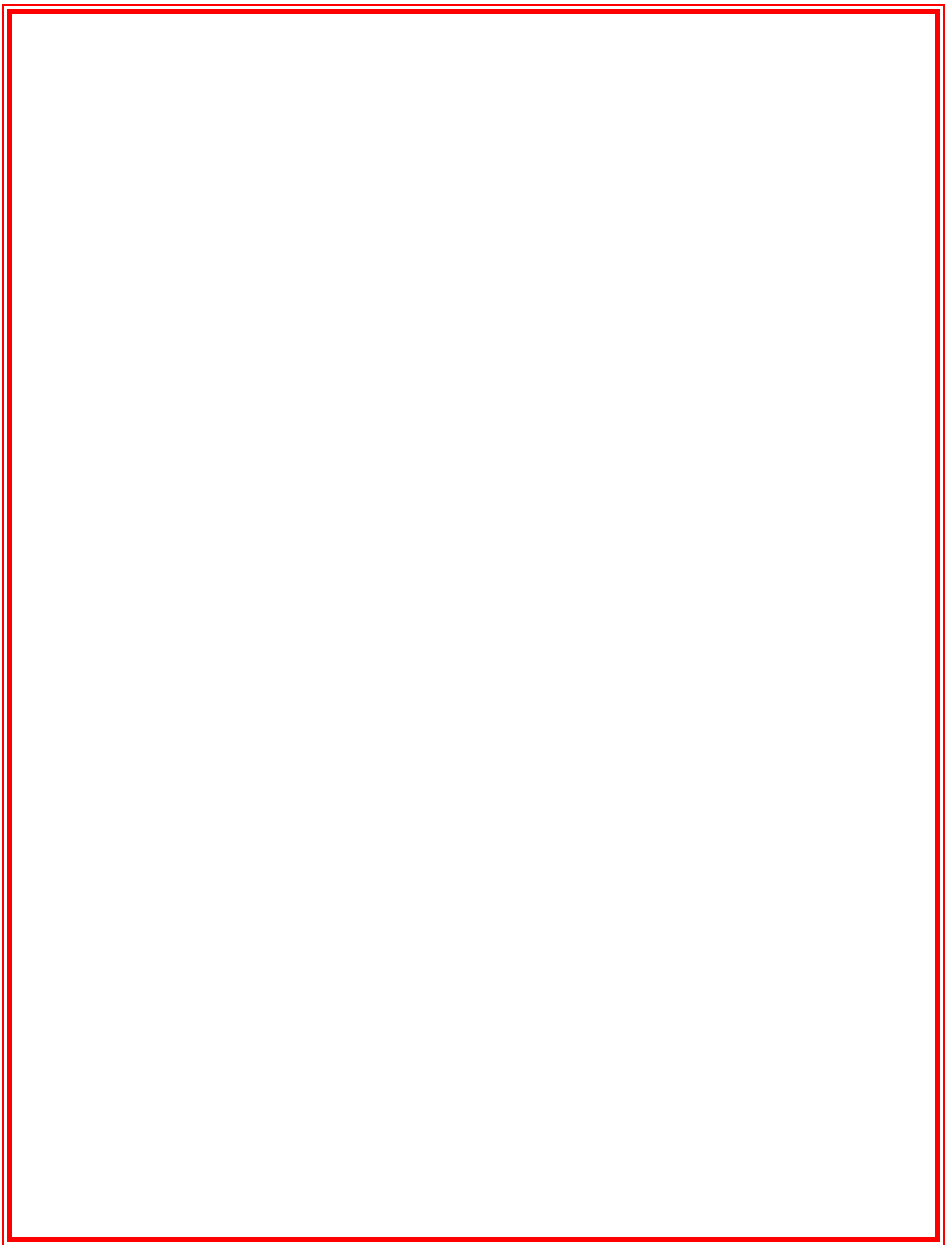
Canada's 150th birthday is being celebrated with great enthusiasm! The children worked together to create an impressive poster. They also made flags and other

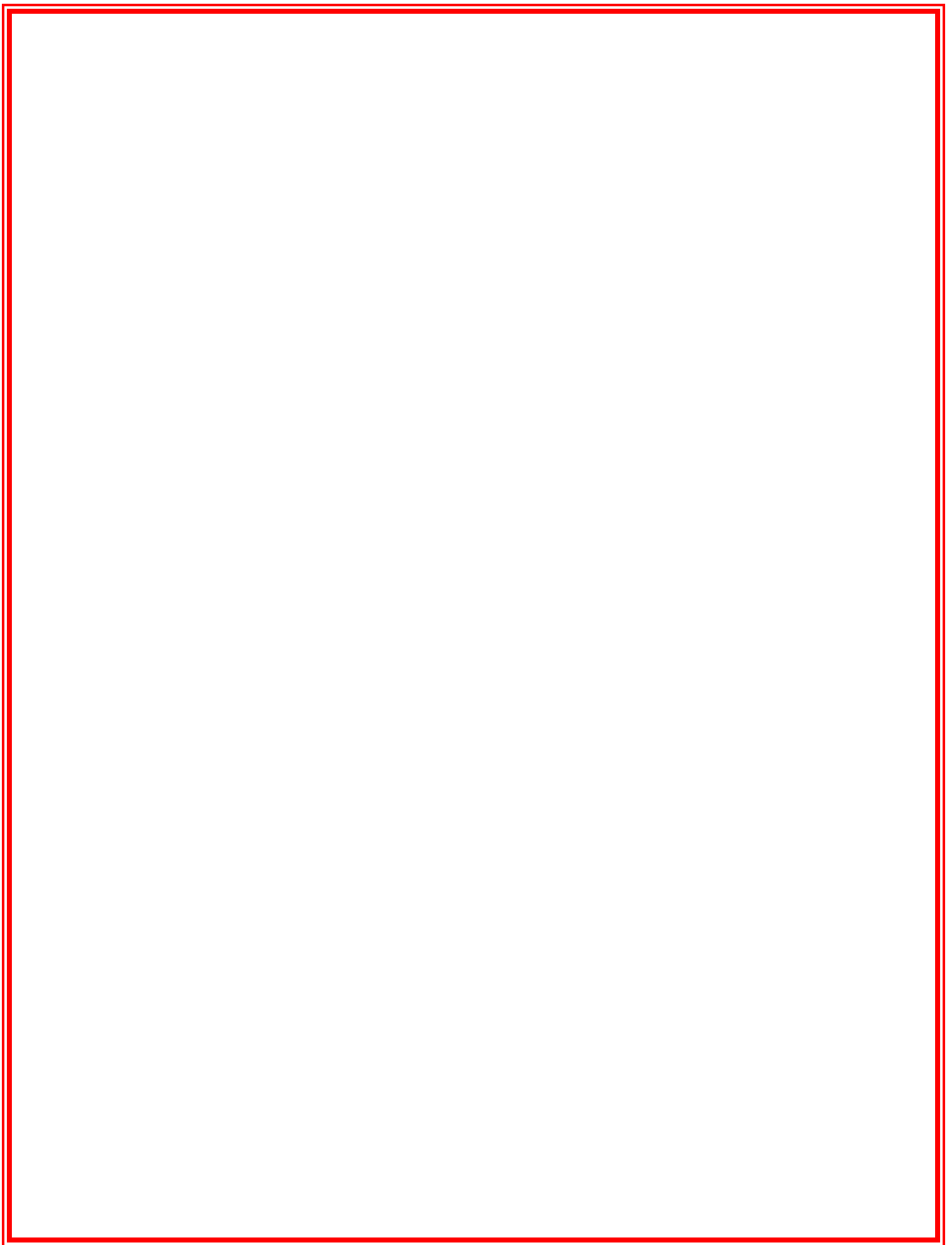


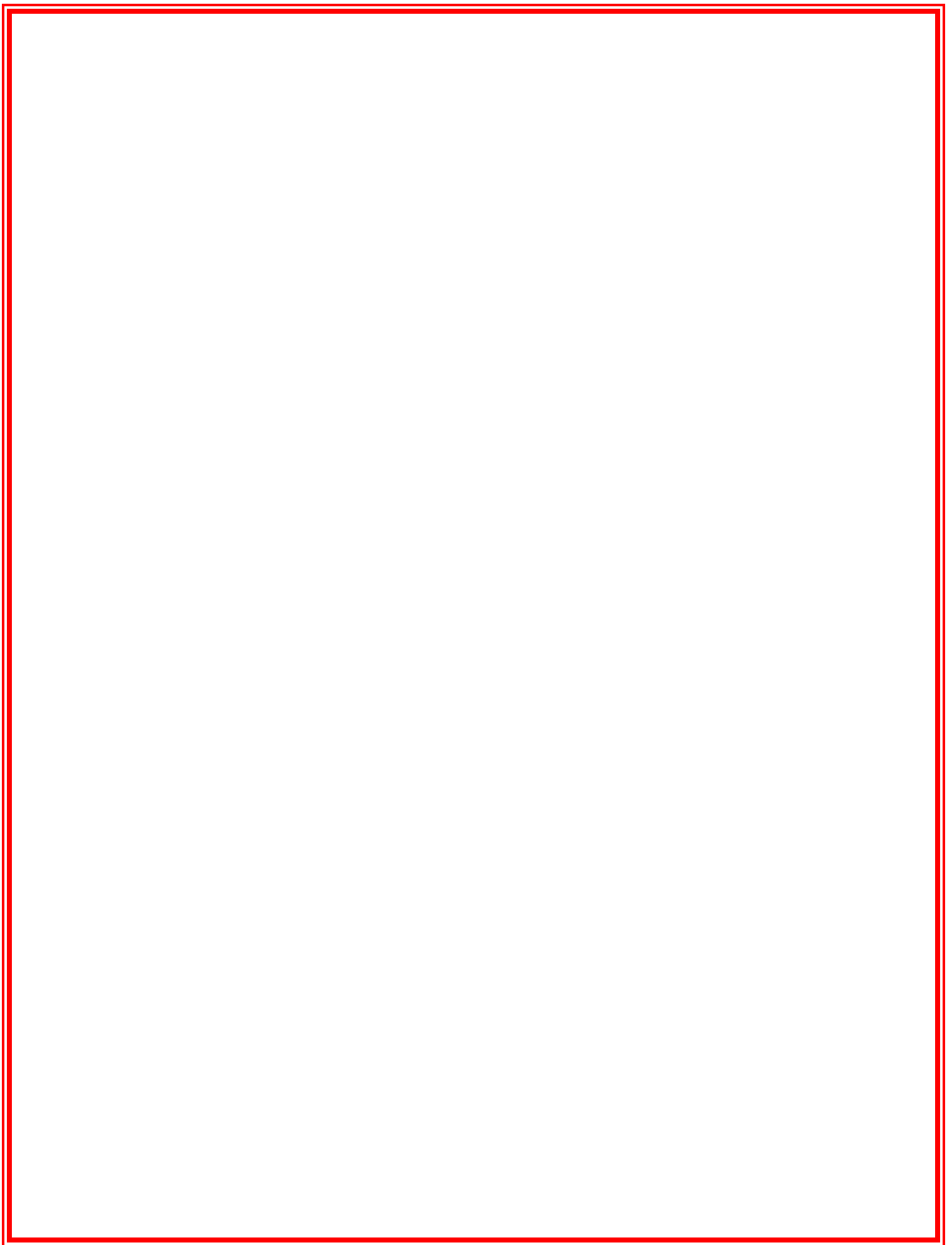
