

]Activity1- Explore with snow



"we can slide down from the snow mountain" Child E

" The snow is so clean" Child M

" Teamwork is the best" Child G

During outdoor playtime, children used different ways to explore with snow. They had built snowmen, created snow mountains, jumped into the snow pile and shoveled snow. Not only had fun, children also learned the importance of teamwork. This is indicated when children work together to roll a big snowball. Child E said " it's so heavy, but I have friends to help me".

Children also learn about shared materials when teachers encourage them to use small shovels when they wait for the big shovel.

#### Activity 2 watercolor Snowflake



We did this activity in two days. On the first day we folded the coffee filter four times, and made cuts into triangles. Teachers show children step by step, before they try it. The younger kids needed a little assistance to cut the small triangles, but they tried it themselves first before they ask for help. On the second day children added food coloring. Teacher explained the process of adding food coloring to the coffee filter called absorption. Child M asked " what does absorption mean?" The

teacher explained Absorption is defined as the process of one thing over becoming part of another thing. In this activity, children were able to practice their cutting skills and learn about absorption.
